MINOR ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION SEVERAL WORKS CERTIFICATE

GUIDANCE FOR RECIPIENTS

This Certificate has been issued to confirm that the electrical installation work to which it relates has been designed, constructed and inspected and tested in accordance with British Standard 7671, (the IET Wiring Regulations).

You should have received an 'original' Certificate and the contractor should have retained a duplicate. If you were the person ordering the work, but not the owner of the installation, you should pass this Certificate, or a copy of it, to the owner. A separate Certificate should have been received for any existing circuit on which minor works have been carried out. This Certificate is not appropriate if you have asked the contractor to undertake more extensive installation work, for which you should have received a Minor Electrical Installation Certificate.

The Certificate should be retained in a safe place and be shown to any person inspecting or undertaking further work on the electrical installation in the future. If you later vacate the property, this Certificate will demonstrate to the new owner that the minor electrical installation work carried out complied with the requirements of British Standard 7671 at the time the Certificate was issued.
